Parent Involvement Rep's Report (Michelle Sooklal) – SAC did not meet in July.

## Principal's Report

- Curriculum/Assessment
  - Students began I-Ready diagnostic testing today.
  - We are awaiting teachers' VAM (Value-Added Model) scores from DOE, which show each teacher's effectiveness in relation to their students' standardized test score results.
  - o The school's Academic Enrichment Program (AEP) will begin next week.
  - SKY now has two advanced track (SOAR) programs for both 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade students, which follows the district's pupil progression program.
  - Improved Physical Education presented by Fred Sosnoski:
    - The first P.E. class of the day for all students consists of fitness stations. These stations focus on different areas such as agility, cardio, legs, core, etc.
    - The second P.E. class of the day is spent playing team sports and learning the proper throws, serves, etc.
    - Students improved their times on the mile run by 30-35 minutes as compared to last school year. The longest run time this year was 15:30. Students also improved their times in week 2 as compared to week 1.
- Business/Long-term planning
  - Enrollment is 231 students at the Englewood campus and 207 students at the Venice campus. Enrollment is down at our Venice campus this year as

well as other charter schools in the Venice area. Numbers show that more students are attending their districted schools.

- We would like to have more of a marketing presence in North Port and have already begun to ramp up the number of posts on SKY's Facebook page. SKY Academy may contract with a marketing professional outside of the YMCA in the near future. Other marketing ideas include:
  - Send photos with news articles to Scott Lockwood at the Venice Gondolier Sun newspaper.
  - Hand out SKY Academy flyers at the gate of the Vikings football games.
  - See if local realtors could give a SKY pamphlet to clients when showing properties in Venice. Perhaps they could also list SKY Academy on their property listings in the section that shows schools in the immediate area.
- Locker room renovations will include new flooring and paint as well as fixing some of the stalls.
- The board meeting schedule was adjusted to six meetings per year (see attached).
- The goal for next year's enrollment is 265 for SKY Englewood and 240 for SKY Venice.
- o Pat Ryan reviewed the 2017-18 proposed budget with the board.

  - Mrs. LoBosco is heading up a parent group that will begin meeting in the next couple weeks. Their first fundraiser will be popcorn sales.
  - The Taste of SKY fundraiser will be held later in the year possibly the week after Easter. Local 5<sup>th</sup> grade students may also be invited to attend.
- Wellness and Nutrition
  - Fitness stations and the mile run were discussed earlier during the Principal's Report.
  - Flag football and volleyball begin this week.

- SKY is enforcing the policy against bringing fast food/drinks with both students and staff.
- The new kitchen in Englewood is up and running as of today. Both schools prepare the same menus. The café is under the direction of Chef Dave in Venice and Chef Ida in Englewood.
