	At 5:05PM discussion was started about the curriculum. Over all the first quarter went well and the majority of students have good grades. There was discussion of how the teachers keep in contact with each other about the students that struggle and work on ways to help them improve. There will be a training for the teachers in Venice on teacher work day Oct 30 th 2015. This training will give them an opportunity to train for I-ready and google classroom. Interactions with the community has brought a lot of positive feedback. One parent, for example, was discussing with one of our leaders how their child coming the SKY Academy has helped make them a strong student with more confidence something they never had before. 	their classes. This starts the week of November 1 st 2015. <u>Business and long term planning-</u> We currently have 98 students at SKY Academy. We enrolled 3 new students in 1 week and lost 1 who was moving up north. We currently have 62 6 th graders and 36 7 th graders. We are already enrolling for the 2016-2017 school year. From what we hear in the community we will have a lot of 6 th graders enrolling next year. Our projection for next year is 190 students for 6 th , 7 th , and 8 th grade.	
Principals Report	Fundraising/ Community Outreach— Currently we are having a fundraiser for our spirit week. Its \$2 a day or \$10 for the week and entry to the dance. Monday- crazy sock day, Tuesday-sports team day, Wednesday- dress like a nerd day, and Thursday-superhero vs. villain day and ending with our dance from 3-5 pm. The dance will be held in our cafeteria and it is super hero themed. We have a good number of parent volunteers to help decorate and chaperone the dance along with our teachers. We will have 6 local restaurants and Chef Dino making samples for our families to try. Students will be putting their health research projects on display and give presentations at the event. They were also talking about having people bring in healthy recipes and create a "Taste of SKY" cookbook.
